The retreat program is designed for first time attendees and silent retreat veterans alike and will include centering prayer, *lectio divina*, praying with nature, yoga and walking the labyrinth.

Silence is sometimes a difficult thing for us to do in this busy world of ours and it can be a little scary. The reward can be a quiet reflective time between you and God. You can use the silence to listen for that still small voice or to rest in the Lord.

Check-in will open at 7:00 p.m. on Friday and the retreat will conclude with a Sunday morning service followed by lunch. You may bring inspirational reading materials, Bibles, journals, inspirational music with earphones or other materials that you feel will help you to be in a deeper relationship with God as you meditate during the day.

Spiritual Director ~ Marlene Miller Krueger is an evangelist with the Community of Christ, ordained in 2010. She has served as a pastor of two congregations (New Orleans, LA & Lewisville, TX). Her most recent training was at the Spiritual Direction Institute and Retreat Center in Houston, Texas. This center is a Catholic center run by the Religious of the Cenacle and her studies were from 2001-2004, a 3 year ecumenical program including practical application experience. She has directed 9 silent retreats hosted by the Live Oak Community of Christ congregation in the Coastal Bend Mission Center and been guest minister at Western Canada Mission Center and Rocky Mountain Mission Center retreats. Additionally, she has conducted 2 silent retreats in her home in Estes Park, CO since moving there in 2005, one for officers of the Community of Christ. She taught a class on group spiritual direction at the Rocky Mountain Mission Center women's retreat held in Wyoming, while the retreat in Canada focused on discernment. Marlene serves on the Community of Christ Spiritual Formation Committee, assisting with teaching sessions at the 2008 and 2009 Peace Colloquies and the January, 2010 Central States Evangelist event at the Temple.

Marlene is married to High Priest, John Krueger. She is the mother of a daughter who is a psychotherapist in Kansas City and a son who is a medical doctor in Ann Arbor, MI. She has 3 grandchildren 10, 7 and 2 years. She has a BA in music education from Graceland University, 1969, and studied nursing at the Tulsa, Oklahoma Junior College, becoming a registered nurse in 1981, serving as camp nurse at numerous church youth camps. An accomplished pianist and organist, she taught piano in the home for 29 years. With her husband, they have directed reunions and youth camps over the years.
