The above fees will cover much of the reunion costs. The remainder of reunion costs will be covered by offerings shared during the evening worship services.

Reunion Housing Reservations: In order to keep reunion costs affordable, this year a new method for housing is being used. Your reunion cost will depend on the kind of housing arrangements you wish to have. You will select both the type of cabin you want as well as the number of persons you want to share it with. The more persons there are in a cabin, the lower the cost per person. It is your choice!

In order to reserve your choice housing accommodations, you will want to register early. Reservations will be received on April 1 and lodging will be assigned on a first registered, first-assigned basis. So please, register early!

What you need to do for housing at the 2007 Reunion

1. Decide on who you want to share your lodging with.
2. Decide on the kind of lodging you want to reserve.
3. Reserve your lodging choice.
4. Decide with your roommates how you will distribute the costs of your lodging choice.

How Much Will it Cost to attend Reunion?

EXAMPLES

Example 1 (for Reunion 1): In this example the Jones family of two adults and one 11 year old youth are reserving a Block Cabin. They have contacted the Smith family of one adult and three youth (ages 5, 13, and 16) to share their reserved cabin.

The cost of program and meals for the Jones family is: 3 persons X \$100/person = \$300.

The cost of program and meals for the Smith family is: 4 persons X \$100/person = \$400.

The total housing cost of one Block Cabin is \$630. The Jones family and the Smith family will be responsible for paying this amount. The two families may divide the cost in a manner that is appropriate for them. If the two families decide to divide the cost of the Block Cabin evenly then the cost per family is as follows:

Reunion Cost for the Jones family: \$300 (meals and program) + \$315 (1/2 of Block Cabin) = \$615.

Reunion Cost for the Smith family: \$400 (meals and program) + \$315 (1/2 of Block Cabin) = \$715.

Example 2 (for Reunion 2): In this example the Deter family of two adults and three children (ages 2, 6, and 9) are reserving a Lodge Room. They have contacted the Morris family of one adult and 2 children (ages 7 and 11) to share their reserved lodge room.

The cost of program and meals for the Deter family is: 1 person (3 and under) is free + 4 persons X \$87/person = \$348.

The cost of program and meals for the Morris family is: 3 persons X \$87/person = \$261.

The total housing cost of one Block Cabin is \$720. The Deter family and the Morris family will be responsible for paying this amount. The two families may divide the cost in a manner that is appropriate for them. If the two families decide to divide the cost of the Lodge room based on the number of persons in the room then the cost per family is as follows:

Reunion Cost for the Deter family: \$348 (meals and program) + \$450 (\$720/8 persons X 5 persons) = \$798.

Reunion Cost for the Morris family: \$261 (meals and program) + \$270 (\$720/8 persons X 3 persons) = \$531.

Example 3 (for Reunion 2): In this example the Thompson family of two adults are reserving an RV site. They have contacted the Ellis family of one adult and 3 children (ages 7, 9, and 16) to share their RV.

The cost of program and meals for the Thompson family is: 2 persons X \$87/person = \$174.

The cost of program and meals for the Ellis family is: 4 persons X \$87/person = \$348.

The total housing cost for one RV Site is \$132. The Thompson family and the Ellis family will be responsible for paying this amount. The two families may divide the cost in a manner that is appropriate for them. If the two families decide to divide the cost of the RV site based on the number of persons in the RV then the cost per family is as follows:

Reunion Cost for the Thompson family: \$174 (meals and program) + \$44 (\$132/6 persons X 2 persons) = \$218.

Reunion Cost for the Ellis family: \$348 (meals and program) + \$88 (\$132/6 persons X 4 persons) = \$436.

NOTE: In all of these examples the cost of housing is variable based on the type of housing selected and the number of persons sharing the room. The total cost of the housing option is set in the registration fee. The distribution of the housing cost among the persons using the room is for them to decide. It is just like renting a motel room for a week and sharing the cost with your roommates. You get to decide!
